

**ORDINANCE NO. 102-08**  
**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REGULATION OF ALTERNATIVE**  
**TRANSPORTATION OF THE TOWN OF FRANKTON**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Town of Frankton, Madison County, Indiana:

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Frankton, Indiana, intends to adopt an ordinance for the regulation of alternative transportation used on the right of ways and roadways of the Town of Frankton.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Town Council of the Town of Frankton, Madison County, Indiana, that the following ordinance is hereby established as to the above described use of alternative transportation:

1. That any operator of alternative transportation must be at least **16 years of age** with a proper photo ID and comply with local and state ordinance and laws. **(SEE AMENDED ORDINANCE #104-09)**
2. Operation of such alternative transportation shall be during daylight hours only, with the exception of units equipped with headlights, taillights, and turn signals may be driven after dark on the Town streets. Operation is not permitted on County roads or State Highways, except for crossing at intersections only. **(SEE AMENDED ORDINANCE #104-09)**
3. Any alternative transportation requires rear view mirrors and slow moving vehicle sign. Restrict limit of passengers to the number of seats on each unit. (Example: bench seats, two passengers only, etc.)
4. Any alternative transportation vehicle or device must be inspected on an annual basis. The inspection cost shall be **\$10.00** per unit to be payable to the Town of Frankton, 108 E. Sigler Street, Frankton, IN 46044 and the inspection shall be conducted by the Frankton Police Department. The purpose of the inspection will be to determine if the unit is safe and in compliance with all related rules and regulations. **(SEE AMENDED ORDINANCE #100-13)**
5. The above described inspections will be conducted by appointments scheduled in advance by the owner. For appointments, contact the Police Department at (765) 754-8833.
6. The owner must renew the inspection on or before May 1<sup>st</sup> annually, by scheduling an appointment as described above. The Frankton Police Department will maintain records of inspection and reserve the right to remove any uninspected or unsafe alternate transportation unit.
7. Each alternate transportation unit must have liability insurance and verification of that insurance must be presented at the time of the above referenced inspection and carried while operating such vehicle.
8. Frankton Town Marshal or Designated Representative will affix an inspection sticker to front drivers side of each unit after a satisfactory inspection has been completed, along with proof of insurance to be filed and recorded.
9. Any violators will be cited for local ordinance violation and fined **\$50.00** for the first offense, **\$75.00** for the second offense and **\$100.00** for the third offense. Additional offenses will result in suspension of use on public roadways for the remainder of the year.
10. For the purpose of this ordinance, alternate transportation is described as any motorized vehicle not requiring to be plated, above 50cc, including but not limited to electric vehicles, golf carts, utility carts, scooters, excluding quad runners and dirt bikes, which are off road vehicles only. **(SEE AMENDED ORDINANCE #104-09)**
11. Parking will be parallel to and on the right in the same direction as the traffic is designed to flow.
12. If a alternative transportation vehicle is sold, the inspection sticker is void. The new owner must have vehicle inspected and follow all rules and regulations as described above.

This ordinance shall not supersede any Indiana State Law or statute as to transportation.

**ORDINANCE #104-09**  
TO AMEND GOLF CART ORDINANCE #102-08

**Be It Ordained**, by the Council for the Town of Frankton, Madison County, Indiana, that Ordinance 102-08 is amended as follows;

Under 1. Omit “be a least 16 years of age with a proper photo ID” and replace with, be a licensed driver under Indiana Law and have such license on his or her person at all times.

Under 2. Omit “except for crossing at intersections only”, to alleviate any confusion for use on county or state highways.

Under 10. Omit “scooters.”

**Be It Ordained**, by the Town Council of Frankton, Madison County, Indiana, that Ordinance #102-08 is amended as follows:

Under 4. Omit, The inspection cost shall be \$10.00 and replace with The inspection cost will be \$25.00.

Under 6. Omit, The Frankton Police Department will maintain records of inspection. Replace with the Frankton Town Clerks office will maintain records of inspection. The Frankton Police Department reserves the Right to remove any uninspected or unsafe alternate transportation unit.

Under 8. Omit, Frankton Town Marshall. Replace with Frankton Town Clerk.
