

**ORDINANCE #104-08**  
**Control of Dogs, Repealing Ordinance #113-82**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council for the Town of Frankton, Madison County, Indiana, that:

Section I – It shall be unlawful for any person being the owner of, or having the care, custody or control of any dog, to allow, suffer or permit such dog to be at large upon the streets or other public places in the town or in or on any other place beyond the premises of such person, unless such dog be on a leash or otherwise under the complete control of a person capable or controlling such dog.


Section II – Any person violating, or failing to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon first offense, receive written notice from the town council of failure to comply. A second offense will result in violation of local ordinance and fined \$25.00 with each offense thereafter to increase by an additional \$25.00. Fines will be payable to the Town of Frankton, 108 E. Sigler Street.


Section III – This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.



**ORDINANCE #101-12**  
**Amendment to Dog Ordinance #104-08**

Be It Ordained, by the Council for the Town of Frankton, Madison County, Indiana, that


Section V - Ordinance #104-08 shall be amended to include imposing additional fines upon dog owners or a property owner where such dogs are harbored, in cases that a dog is transported to the Animal Protection League by the Frankton Police Department the Town will pay a per incident fee on a monthly basis to the Animal Protection League for (1) cases involving dog bites, (2) if the Police Department is unable to identify a proper address for a loose dog. The Police Department shall comply with paper work procedures required by the facility. Upon identifying the dog owner or property owner, the Police Department shall issue a fine of \$200.00 per incident, payable at the Frankton Town Hall. This fine is due regardless of whether a person has previously violated this Ordinance or Ordinance #104-08 and regardless of whether written notices or previous fines were issued.


Section VI - This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.


Section VII - This Ordinance repeals all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict therewith.
