

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE BURNING OF TRASH  
AND OTHER ARTICLES DURING CERTAIN HOURS IN  
THE TOWN OF FRANKTON, MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA,  
AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, for the safety of the residents of the Town of Frankton, Indiana, and to prevent an accumulation of smoke during the evening and night hours, it is deemed necessary to limit open burning during certain hours

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF FRANKTON, MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION I - That no person shall burn or cause to be burned any trash, lumber, leaves, straw, or any other combustible material between the hours of 5:30 P.M. and 6:00 A.M. the next succeeding day, and that all fires which have been burning must be extinguished by 5:30 P.M.

SECTION II - There shall be no burning of trash, lumber, leaves, straw, or any other combustible material on Sunday.



SECTION III - That in the burning of any trash, lumber, leaves, straw, or other combustible material, the same shall be burned in a safe place so as not to endanger surrounding property and shall not be burned on any asphaltic or tar streets, and shall not be burned in a manner or in such a large amount as to cause damage to others.

SECTION IV - This ordinance specifically prohibits the burning of any garbage at any time within the corporate limits of the Town of Frankton, Indiana.

SECTION V - Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance may be fined in any amount not exceeding Twenty-five Dollars (25.00) in an action brought in the proper court for the violation of the same.


SECTION VI - This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and posting thereof according to law.
